

PATIENT PORTAL ACCESS INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Provide a valid cell phone number at the time of registration.
- 2. You will be sent a text message to that number that contains a link to set up your account. You must use this link to set up your Patient Portal account. This link is unique to each patient and should not be shared.
- 3. Click on the link in the text message and follow the instructions. You will create an account using the first letter of your first name and your complete last name (Example: If your name is **John Smith**, your username will be **jsmith**.) Use the name you provided at registration. You will also be asked to create a password and set up a security question.
- 4. Once your information has been entered and your account is registered you will be taken to a "Welcome" screen.
- 5. Click on "Patient Portal" in the top right corner of the screen and you will be taken to the Dashboard, where you can access any patient medical information that is available. **MAKE CHANGES**
- 6. To return to the Dashboard after viewing a document, click on the green house symbol in the menu in the top right corner of the screen.
- 7. To log out, click the blue arrow in the menu in the top right corner of the screen.


